SAFEUT IS COMING TO PARKVIEW

The SafeUT Crisis Text and Tip Line is a statewide service that provides real-time crisis intervention to youth through texting and a confidential tip program – right from your smartphone.

Licensed clinicians are available on a 24/7 Crisis Line call center respond to all incoming chats, texts, and calls by providing:

- Supportive or crisis counseling,
- Suicide prevention,
- Referral services.

We can help anyone with emotional crises, bullying, relationship problems, mental health, or suicide related issues.*

SafeUT is free, anonymous, and confidential.

In addition to the crisis line students can also access a tip line that is manned by administration and the school counselor. Tips will be investigated to ensure the physical and emotional safety of all our students. This tip line can

be used in the case of bullying, threats, or any instance where a child feels that there is a threat to the safety of our school.

SafeUT will be a valuable asset to our school community. We will go live January 9, 2017.
