The three areas are:

1. Continue to work on improving math proficiency and skills in the upper grade classes.

3. Improve the instruction during our English Language Development time. *(This is the time when students who are second language learners go to different classes to learn how to improve their reading, writing, listening, and speaking skills. We need to look at what our students who are proficient in English are learning during that time.)*
