-Mrs. Bergera told the parents to let school employees know if there are any reports of bullying. Parkview staff wants all of our students to feel safe and supported at school. If students are experiencing bullying it affects their emotional well being and learning and performance at school.

-Mr. Yates gave an update our school improvement goals and talked about the progress we are making on the goals.

-One parent requested to discuss at the next meeting how parents express concerns about their child and get help for them through special education.
