Parkview Families,

We have had a busy couple of weeks completing our WIDA testing for our second language learners. This test is very important to help us determine what support and instruction students need to become proficient in speaking, reading, listening, and writing in English. The test results determine how we group students into classes for their English language development instruction. Last year our English language learners made 20% growth in Language Arts and Science on the end of year tests. Our teachers and students are working hard to improve their language proficiency. Thank you to Mrs. Ceribasic for coordinating the testing for our school.

Attendance continues to be a concern and issue for many of our students. We want you to know how much we miss your children when they are not in school. To help motivate our students, we will start handing out a most improved attendance award at our weekly assembly. We want the students to know that we recognize when they are making improvements.

Our upper grade classes are participating in the state SAGE interim tests. These tests were

designed to monitor students' progress throughout the year before they take the end of the year SAGE test. The teachers will use the test results to determine how well students can demonstrate their knowledge and mastery on concepts and standards they have learned so far this year. We know that sometime these tests can be difficult for some of our students but we also know they can do it. We believe in our Parkview Panthers. Please encourage your child to work hard and be determined to stick with it even if something is hard.
