COUNSELING CORNER

Parkview grades K-4 has been working on learning to notice our feelings through the use of the Grump Meter. The Grump Meter is a tool that works like a thermometer to gauge feelings. Each color of the Grump Meter has a meaning on the bottom is blue-calm, then green-grumpy, then yellow-be careful, then orange-stop, and on top is red-explode. Your student learned to describe their mood using this scale. Each class was given a Grump Meter poster and each student made their own Grump Meter bookmark.
