Parkview Families,

This week our students participated in an assembly with the Utah Attorney General's Office called NetSmartz. Students learned about the 4 rules of internet safety:

1. Tell my trusted adult if anything makes me feel sad, scared, or confused.
2. Ask my trusted adult before sharing information like my name, address, and phone number.
3. NOT meet face-to-face with anyone from the internet.
4. Always use good netiquette and not be rude or mean online.

In society today, it is important as a parent to watch what your children are doing on the internet. Students have many devices available for them to access the internet. The school has internet software and filters set up to monitor what websites students can access. The filters block anything with inappropriate content. A report of blocked websites with the user name are sent to the school administration on a regular basis. When there are questions or concerns about any student's computer activities, we talk with the student and the teacher. We want our students to

use the internet as a learning tool. Please talk with your student at home about what they learned from the assembly and how you can keep them safe on the internet.
