WHEN IS SICK TOO SICK FOR SCHOOL?

Keep students at **HOME** if they:

Have a **Fever** of 100 or more
Have **Diarrhea**
Are **Vomiting**
Have **Pink Eyes** that are crusty

They are okay to come to **SCHOOL** if they:

Have a runny nose
Have a slight cough
No fever for 24hrs
No vomiting or diarrhea for 24hrs

Go to the **DOCTOR** if:

Fever is 100 or more for more than two days

Throwing up or diarrhea for more than two days

Sniffles for more than a week and not getting better
