School Improvement Plan Update

Math Goal

Math scores on each interim assessment in grades 3, 4, & 5 will increase by a minimum of 5% in comparison to the results from 2016-2017. The end-of-year Student Assessment of Growth and Excellence (SAGE) scores in grades 3, 4, & 5 will increase a minimum of 5% in comparison to the 2017 SAGE end of-year scores.

ELL Goal

75% of ELL students will increase their composite score on World-class Instructional Design and Assessment (WIDA) as compared to their composite scores in 2017.

Attendance Goal

The number of students with chronic and severe chronic absence percentages will drop by a minimum of 5% from the 2016-2017 school year. The school team will work collaboratively with parents and the student to improve regular school attendance.

No vomiting or diarrhea for 24hrs

Go to the **DOCTOR** if:

Fever is 100 or more for more than two days

Throwing up or diarrhea for more than two days

Sniffles for more than a week and not getting better
